Originally established as Gulshanara Nursing Institute in 2019 under BNMC & MH&FW, it launched a three-year Diploma in Nursing Science & Midwifery program. In 2020, GNC gained affiliation with the University of Dhaka and introduced a four-year Bachelor of Science (BSc) in Nursing and a two-year Post Basic BSc in Nursing. Upholding international standards, GNC has quickly become a center of excellence, significantly contributing to Bangladesh's healthcare sector.

Spreading Smiles and Awareness: My Experience from the School Health Visit at Gulshanara School

On December 17, 2023, I had the opportunity to be part of a meaningful initiative under our Community Health Nursing course — a school health visit at Gulshanara School. As a 3rd-year B.Sc. in Nursing student from the 2020–21 session, this visit gave me a chance to step out of the classroom and into a real community setting, where I could make a direct impact.

I was part of the team responsible for educating the school children about dental caries. From the very beginning, our goal was clear — to raise awareness about the importance of oral health and to teach children how to care for their teeth properly. I knew that developing healthy dental habits early could prevent many future problems, and I wanted to deliver that message in a way that was simple, engaging, and fun.

Standing in front of a group of bright, curious students, I felt a mix of excitement and

nervousness. But the moment I began my session, their smiles and eagerness to learn made all my anxiety disappear. I used visual aids, simple models, and real-life examples to explain what causes dental caries and how brushing twice a day, limiting sugary snacks, and visiting the dentist regularly could help prevent them.

What made the experience even more rewarding was the interaction. The children asked thoughtful questions — some even shared stories of their own dental issues. I ended the session with a quiz to reinforce their learning, and their enthusiasm was

heartwarming. When I announced the winners and handed out small prizes, the joy on their faces made everything worthwhile.

Our teachers were with us throughout, guiding and encouraging us. Their presence ensured that the program ran smoothly and that we maintained a professional yet friendly atmosphere. I also learned a lot by watching how my fellow team members communicated



and adapted their messages based on the children's responses.

This visit wasn't just about teaching children — it was also a journey of learning for me. I realized the power of health education in shaping young minds and how even a short session can plant seeds of lifelong healthy habits. It helped me build my confidence, sharpen my communication skills, and understand my role as a future nurse educator.

I'm really thankful to our college for giving us this chance. I hope we get to do more programs like this in the future!

When The Hills wear Colors

Nestled in the southeastern corner of Bangladesh, the hill tracts are home to a world of breathtaking landscapes, vibrant cultures,

and age-old traditions. As the season changes and the hills bloom with life, the indigenous communities light up the region with festivals full of colors, music, and joy. These moments, when tradition meets celebration, are when the hills truly “wear colors.”



The Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) region of Bangladesh is home to numerous indigenous communities, collectively known as the Jumma people. The major indigenous groups in this region include the Chakma (the largest indigenous group in CHT), Marma, Tripura, Mro, Bawm, Khumi, Lushai, and Pangkhao. Each community has its own cultural identity, traditional clothing, and spiritual beliefs.



One of the most exciting and widely celebrated festivals is Sangrai, the traditional New Year of the Marma community,

observed in mid-April. The most famous part of Sangrai is the water festival, where people—especially the youth, joyfully splash water on one another in the streets or in an arranged place. This fun and friendly water fight is not just about play; it’s deeply symbolic. Water represents cleaning of the past year’s negativity and welcoming the New Year with fresh hope, blessings, and happiness.

The **Biju festival** is celebrated during the same period and lasts three days:

1. The first day is called Phool Biju, where homes are cleaned and decorated with flowers.
2. The second day, Mul Biju, is the main day of celebration with

special foods, cultural shows, and visits to neighbors.

3. The final day, Gojjepojje Din, is reserved for visiting elders and paying respect through religious offerings.

The **Boisu festival**,

observed by the Tripura people, is a joyful New Year celebration



with traditional

drumming, folk songs, dance, and the preparation of special dishes.

The Bawm community also observes several significant cultural and religious festivals throughout the year:

1. Khuado Pawi (Harvest Festival).
2. Nau Panzawi (New Year festival).
3. Christmas.

The festivals of the CHT bring the hills to life with color, joy, and tradition. Each



celebration reflects the unique identity of its people and their deep connection to culture and nature. As

these hills wear their festive colors, they remind us of the beauty of diversity and the importance of preserving indigenous heritage for generations to come.
